The meeting was presided over by Shri Debashis Goswami, ACS, Co-District Commissioner, Rangia. At the outset, the chairman welcomed all the members present.

The meeting started with departmental PowerPoint presentations and subsequently, the following decisions were taken.

P & RD	<p>The House discussed the Orunodoi, MGNREGA, PMAY-G, Untied Fund, and AAGY schemes under the Rangia Development Block.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In response to a query from the Chair, the AEE, O/o BDO, Rangia Development Block informed that the performance of the PMAY-G scheme is poor in some GPs due to the inclusion of new GPs transferred from the Kamalpur Development Block to the Rangia Development Block after delimitation. The Chairman directed that the matter be reviewed to ensure necessary progress. • Regarding the inclusion of a road scheme near Baidyaghar LP School under MGNREGA, the BDO, Rangia Development Block informed that the said scheme has already been included in the Annual Action Plan, which is yet to be approved. • It was informed that UCs (Utilization Certificates) for the AAGY schemes are yet to be submitted. School has reached 99% completion.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The AEE, PWD (Building) further informed that the earth-filling work at the newly sanctioned scheme — Athgaon Binapani High School — is proposed to be taken up from another scheme.
