Subject	Minutes of the Meeting of District Development Committee of Kamrup District
Date & Time	20 th of May, 2026 at 11:00 AM
Venue	Conference Hall, O/o CDC, Rangia

The meeting was chaired by Sri Deba Kumar Mishra, ACS, DC, Kamrup and Sri Bhabesh Kalita, Hon’ble MLA, Rangia LAC graced the meeting with his presence. The meeting started with welcome address from Sri Susanta Kumar Dutta, ACS, DDC, Kamrup followed by a discussion on action taken report from the earlier DDC Meeting.

Also, following interdepartmental issues were raised:

1. Executive Engineer,PWD, Hajo-Sualkuchi TRD apprised that regarding drainage works in Kalibari-SrinathPatty, Amingaon area a meeting with officials representing Jal Board has been scheduled and in this regard the outcome will be intimated to the District Authority at the earliest.
2. EE, PWD, Hajo-Sualkuchi TRD, informed that land acquisition for the Kulhati-Bongsor Road is on hold because of the non-conversion of Miyadi land to Govt. land. DC directed ADC (revenue) to take up the issues and visit the site with the Executive Engineer. .
3. EE, PWD, SKTRD apprised the house that as directed by DC in the last DDC Meeting a letter to Chief Engineer, PWD (Roads) has been sent regarding the issue pertaining to Construction of ROB in Maniari Tiniali
4. EE PWD, SKTRD, apprised additional land acquisition for in the approach road to IIM, Guwahati, Jt. Survey with District Administration is conducted.
5. Regarding the project funded by World Bank for which LA and Zeerat is pending for 14 nos. of bridges, EE,PWD, NKTRD that LA compensation has been deposited in District Authorities bank account and requested for initiating the payment process so as to enable PWD to start the work. ADC (LA) in this regard informed that as 6 nos. of bridges comes under AIDC land. DC directed CDC Rangia to carry out joint verification and submit the report at the earliest.
6. Regarding Internal Committee under POSH Act, DSWO, W&CD, Kamrup informed that few departments are yet to notify internal committee such that the data can be uploaded in SHE Box Portal. DDC requested departments to ensure compliance.
7. CDC, Rangia informed that a locals have been complaining regarding waterlogging issues in a road in Jamtola of Madhya Panduri GP and requested EE, NKTRD to visit the location. EE PWD, NKTRD informed that since the road is a kutcha road and doesn’t come under the purview of PWD. DC directed BDO Rangia to take necessary steps and solve the waterlogging issue at the earliest. CDC Rangia was also directed to communicate a written instruction to BDO and take note of the steps taken by the BDO.
8. Regarding parking issue raised by EO Rangia MB in Rangia Municpal Board area, DC directed CDC to convene a joint meeting with CDSP and make necessary arrangement for regulation of traffic and EO RMB to submit a formal letter to CDC Rangia in this regard.
9. EE, PWD (Roads), Hajo Sualkuchi TRD raised a issue regarding the Boundary Wall of the Swimming Pool to be constructed by PWD, NKTBD in Amingaon wherein they have informed that since the existing road is slated for widening and expansion for a 6 lane approach road, construction of boundary wall for the proposed swimming pool comes under the demarcated land of proposed 6 lane road, would lead to demolition of boundary during construction. DC directed EE, PWD, NKTBD to take necessary action accordingly.
10. EE, PWD SKTRD informed that as NHIDCL is not maintaining the existing road (OLD) of Bongara- Satpukhuri NH , the same may be handed over to PWD, SKTRD by NHIDCL whereas a joint survey is to be done before handing over process. As NHIDCL was absent in the meeting DC directed EE, PWD, SKTRD to communicate formally through the Chief Engineer.
11. APDCL informed issue regarding installation of 57 nos. of Electricity Pole in Gopeswar RF, where the residents have Pattas under Foresrt Rights Act and Forest officials have prohibited any work and letter to Forest Official has been communicated in this regard. DC directed to take up the matter with DFO

APDCL also apprised regarding the petitions submitted by various residents of Namtarabari and Upper Tarabari area for electricity connection in the area. On their visit for the purpose few residents have objected the move citing they are under Meghalaya and requested the forest officials for intervention.

12. EE, PWD, NKTRD informed that since the residents of Borolia embankment have been deprived of the previous LA compensation against the embankment works executed by Water Resource Department, they have objected of any road construction in the embankment. DC directed CDC Rangia to jointly visit the area with EE PWD, NKTRD and submit a detailed report. DC also directed EE, PWD to not put the work on hold.
