

MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 30th June, 2022 IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE OFFICE OF THE INTEGRATED DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, KAMRUP, AMINGAON.

The meeting was chaired by District Development Commissioner, Kamrup and District Heads of Kamrup District were present in the meeting. After a threadbare discussion about the monthly progress of the various departments the following actionable points were highlighted.

1	PWD (B)	DDC, Kamrup asked to Ex. Eng. PWD Jalukbari and Guwahati West Territorial Building Division about the progress of the schemes implemented by PWD, Deptt.'s in Kamrup District. He was informed that the project 'Construction of Kalitakuchi Market Shed, Hajo' was being delayed due to laggardly works of the contractor. DDC, Kamrup asked HOD to take up the issue and resolve it expediently.	PWD(B)
2	Water Resources Deptts	The HODs apprised the house about the damages caused to the embankments and nearby road during the unprecedented flood in the District. DDC, Kamrup directed to the PWD(R) and Water Resources Department to quantify those damages plug the same in coordination with each other.	All Head of the Departments
3	Education	DEEO, Kamrup apprised the House that the list of schools and AWC to be covered under JJM had been submitted. He added that post flood review of the projects in the submerged school would be conducted. He thanked the HODs for their help in successful conduction of the Gunotsav 2022 and also mentioned that 8 schools were left out from this year's Gunotsav. He further apprised the house that pass percentage in the HSLC 2022 examination in Kamrup District is 65%. Similarly, the pass percentage in the HS Science, Arts and Commerce are 95%, 83% and 90% respectively.	1. PHE 2. DEEO

4	Khadi & Village Industry	The Khadi & Village industry Dept. has informed the house the distribution of Khadi shirts/shawl to Grade IV employee of the district had been delayed due to flood and they were going to start the process from 1 st July.	All HODs concerned
5	FOREST	DFO, Kamrup West reiterated the need to seek NOC from Forest Department before starting electricity wiring project in the reserve areas. She also added that recently a Hoolock Gibbon had died in an unfortunate incident due to exposed electricity wire. 		<p>She informed DDC, Kamrup that a new reserve area had been sanctioned and much of this proposed area falls under revenue land of Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council.</p> <p>In the matter of disbursement of ex-gratia to the victims of crop damage or death due to wild animals such as Elephants, she let the house know that the joint verification from the concerned Circle Officers are yet to be received.</p> <p>DFO, Kamrup West apprised the house that there is a proposal to create a buffer area around the Gijang Reserve Forest. DDC, Kamrup asked DFO to coordinate with CO, Boko for the necessary delimitation of the area.</p>	
6	Animal Husbandry	I/c SDVO, Rangia informed the House that post flood analysis by a medical team is being conducted and till now not sign of epidemic has been detected.	i/c SDVO, Rangia
8	APDCL	AGM, APDCL apprised the house that electrification of AWC in the Boko and Bongaon block was yet to be completed. They informed that concrete poles couldn't be carried to those area and as an alternative a proposal for steel pole had been submitted.	APDCL
9	Sports	District Sports Officer informed that the Governor's Girls' Volleyball Mission is ongoing in Kamrup District. The issue of development of field of Rampur High School is being resolved, says the HOD.
