

MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING OF KAMRUP DISTRICT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2023

Date of Meeting: 18/04/2023

Venue: Conference Hall of the Integrated Deputy Commissioner's Office, Kamrup, Amingaon

The list of members present in the meeting is enclosed in Annexure A.

The meeting was presided over by the Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup. The chairperson extended Bihu Greetings and welcomed all District Officials.

The District Development Commissioner, Kamrup called upon District Co-ordinator of Nehru Yuva Kendra (NYK), Kamrup to explain about 'Yuva Utsav' to be organised as a single day program by NYK.

The Co-ordinator informed the house that the program will be funded by the Ministry of Sports and Youth Welfare and last year the same was held in Rangia College. As a part of the program, Painting, Poem Writing, Photography competitions and also Talent Hunt, Cultural competitions will take place.

Above that a list of other programs are also included as per guidelines, such as some Games & Sports, Drone Exhibition by Ministry of Civil Aviation, 5G technology Demo by MEITY, Covid Vaccination Stall by H& FW Deptt, Nano Urea Awareness Stall by Agriculture Deptt., Heritage Stall by Deptt. Of Higher Education, Skill Development Stalls by MSDE, PMKVY, NSDM, Cultural Programs and competitions by Cultural Deptt. Etc.

The DDC suggested the Co-ordinator to visit some colleges of Kamrup District for suitable venue for the program and to make necessary arrangements with the officials of the institutions and also appealed other Departments to co-operate in organising the program.

The District Development Commissioner, Kamrup took a brief review on the progress of the issues according to last DDC Meeting Minutes and the following important points were noted.

- The following other points were also discussed during the meeting :
- a) The District Development Commissioner directed all the Departments to go through the letters related to Deputy Commissioner Conference and Chief Secretaries Conclave and to prepare and submit the action points pertaining to the Departments of the Districts.
- b) DDC also directed all the departments to submit Success Stories of youths in various fields as mentioned in the letter received from Hon'ble Chief Minister's office for uploading the same to the web portal.
- c) Some inter Departmental issues were discussed, as listed below :
 1. Some of the pipes installed by PHE for PWSS gets damaged during construction of roads by PWD.
Suggestions given to make the Pipelines Underground and below 1ft. as the digging during the widening of roads is done till 1 ft.
 2. PHE requested to APDCL for giving approving authority in AGM level for the schemes below 3Lakh.
 3. PWD(R) informed the house that one Electric Pole is inside the road area creating an accident prone situation, chair directed departments to write to their higher authority for necessary directions on the issue.
- d) Irrigation, Hajo-Jalukbari Division and also PHE Div.1 informed house about the issue of Electrical Motor theft from the scheme sites. During the discussion on the matter the chair expressed grave concern and assured to talk with Superintendent of Police, Kamrup for taking necessary action.
- e) Chairperson instructed all the Departments to prepare comparative report of the progress of the schemes for presenting in the DDC meeting of the upcoming month.
- Lastly, the Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup directed the remaining Departments to present PPTs in the next DDC meeting and concluded the meeting with vote of thanks to all Officers and representatives of various Departments present in the meeting.
