

MINUTES OF THE DDMA MEETING HELD IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF
THE OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, KAMRUP, AMINGAON, ON
19th JULY, 2019 at 03: 00 PM

The meeting was chaired by the Deputy Commissioner and Chairman, DDMA, Kamrup, Amingaon. At the outset, Addl. Deputy Commissioner and CEO, DDMA welcomed everyone and briefed about the agenda of the meeting. The points of discussion of the meeting are as follows:

1. Infrastructure damage in respect of all the departments may be assessed and financial implication to restore the damage. Report to be submitted to the finance department with a copy to the Revenue and DM department by 23rd July, 2019, so as to enable for inclusion in the next budget provision.
2. All Circle Officers are to submit a list of affected families whose houses got partially/ fully damaged and have taken shelter in the relief centers.
3. With the receding of water level, before the inmates leave for their respective houses they are supposed to be provided with financial assistance of Rs. 3800/- for clothing and utensils. List to be submitted by 20th July, 2019.
4. Joint Director Health Services and District Veterinary Officer to set up Health/ Animal Health Camps in the affected areas in consultation with the respective Circle Officers.
5. PHED to take steps for disinfecting the drinking water sources by providing Halogen tablets and to maintain hygiene by spreading bleaching powder.
6. Hon'ble Minister of Finance, Health etc. Sri Himanta Biswa Sarma has intimated that there will be 5 nos. Mega Health camps in each flood affected LAC's for which an amount of Rs.1 lac will be provided. Similarly for veterinary department 50,000/- will be provided to conduct the Animal Health camps.
7. District Agriculture Officer to make an assessment on crop damages and to prepare a seed distribution plan for the affected farm families.
8. Deputy Director Supply take necessary steps to check the price escalation of essential food items.
9. DSWO to mobilize the CDPOs, Anganwadi workers for preparation of a list of flood affected children and mothers, from the age group 0-2, 2-6 years and to identify the pregnant/ lactating mothers for providing supplementary nutrition. He is also requested to prepare a list of flood damage Anganwadi Centers.
