

Minutes of the meeting of the DDMA, Kamrup for approval of SDRF Damaged Proposals (for Flood/Storm damage) submitted by various Departments in Kamrup District on 19th October, 2021 at 10 am in the Conference Hall of the Office of Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup.

Venue: Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup.

Date & Time: 19th October, 2021 at 10 am.

Participants: at Annexure-I.

The meeting was chaired by the Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup welcoming the participants the Deputy Commissioner and Chairperson, DDMA, Kamrup said that the meeting was called to finalize the Flood/ Storm damaged SDRF proposals submitted by the various departments for the flood 2021.

Initiating the discussion, the SDO, Sadar, Kamrup pinpointed that the minutes of the Circle Level Task Force meeting in which the damage proposals were approved needs to be submitted to DDMA on or before 22nd October, 2021 positively, to facilitate DDMA to submit the same to the Government.

1. APDCL, Mirza Division (Storm damage)
2. Agriculture department for crop damage
3. Water Resource, PGP Mirza Division

Apart from the above damage proposals, SDO, Sadar requested all the Circle Officers to submit damage proposals from various departments approved in the Circle Level Task Force meeting before 31st October, 2021.

The Sr. ADO, Agriculture Department informed that beneficiaries will be getting crop damage compensations only if one-third damage is done from the total agricultural area. The Deputy Commissioner pointed out that there should be no duplicity in getting the Rehabilitation Grants.

The Deputy Commissioner stated that there will be no more DDMA meeting to approve flood damage proposals for the current flood season. Whatever damage proposals are to be approved by the Circle Level Task Force may be approved and send it by Friday, the 22nd October, 2021.


Regarding the pending ex-gratia cases the Deputy Commissioner directed all the Circle Officers to clear up all the backlogs within a month, so that further processing of the ex-gratia cases becomes easy and less time consuming.

The Engineers from Water Resource Department stated the Government did not accord approval to some proposals which were submitted and approved in the last year's DDMA meeting. This year though there was less impact of flood in the district, even then, some of those embankments/banks were further damaged and the Water Resource department had to resubmit the proposals for accord of approval by DDMA.


