Subject	Minutes of the Meeting of District Development Committee of Kamrup District
Date & Time	20 <sup>th</sup> of February, 2026 at 12:00 PM
Venue	AIIDC, Chattabari, Chaygaon, Kamrup

The meeting was chaired by Sri Deba Kumar Mishra, ACS, DC, Kamrup. The meeting started with welcome address from Sri Susanta Kumar Dutta, ACS, DDC, Kamrup followed by a discussion on action taken report from earlier meeting. Also, following inter departmental issues were addressed during the meeting:

1. Executive Engineer, PWD (Roads) , North Kamrup TRD has requested ADC (Revenue) to expedite the sanction of LA compensation regarding ROB at SK 12 so that work could be started in field.
2. EE, Water Resource , Kamrup Rural Division has raised a concern over selecting Digzari Beel for a Wetland Development Project whereas another ADB funded project implemented by Fishery department for the development of that beel is in ongoing stage. In light of this, District Commissioner, Kamrup has asked Sri Bikram Chettry, ACS, ADC ,Kamrup, EE, Water Resource, EE, Pwd (Roads), Hajo-Sualkuchi TRD and DFDO, Kamrup to jointly visit the location and then conduct a meeting at the Office chamber of DC, Kamrup for laying out suitable plan of action for the issue.
3. EE, PWD (Roads), South Kamrup TRD discussed the issue regarding the approach road to site selected for setting up AMUL . As apprised by EE, PWD (Roads), South Kamrup TRD, they have taken up estimate for installing Box Culvert above that irrigation canal and has already intimated the same to the Irrigation department. However, approval of the same is yet to receive from Irrigation department's end. The EE, Irrigation Dept has intimated that matter has been apprised to the higher authority for approval. District Commissioner, Kamrup has asked the Officer from Irrigation Dept to write formally to the EE, PWD (Roads) regarding specific requirements of length width etc. of the proposed culvert over the Irrigation canal, if any, within 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2026 for early implementation of the scheme.
4. DO, Soil Conservation, South Bank Division has requested before the house seeking co-operation with P&RD Dept to revive PMKSY 1.0 schemes in the district. DC, Kamrup asked DO, Soil Conservation, South Bank Division to share the list of such schemes to CEO, Kamrup
