**MINUTES OF THE CO-DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (CDDC)  
MEETING, RANGIA, FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2026**

The meeting was presided over by Smt Jiljily Thaosen, ACS, Assistant Commissioner, Rangia. At the very beginning, she welcomed all the members present.

The meeting started with departmental PowerPoint presentations, and subsequently, the following decisions were taken.

P & RD	<p>The House discussed the MGNREGA, PMAY-G, Untied Fund, MPLADS and AAGY schemes under Rangia Development Block.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•The Chairperson expressed dissatisfaction with the progress of works under MGNREGA and PMAY-G. Consequently, the Assistant Executive Engineer (AEE) of Rangia Development Block was directed to ensure project completion within the stipulated timeframe. Furthermore, the Chairperson noted the repetitive use of identical photographs in the CDDC meeting presentations; the AEE was strictly instructed to provide updated visual evidence reflecting actual site progress. Additionally, photographic documentation of meetings with the public and Gram Panchayat (GP) Secretaries must be included in future reports.</li> <li>● In response to a query from the Chair, the AEE of Rangia Development Block reported that the vendor has replaced only one Solar Street Light under the AAGY scheme to date. Taking a serious view of the delay, the Chair once again directed the BDO, Rangia, to expedite the submission of the pending Utilization Certificates (UC) related to the scheme without further delay.</li> <li>● Regarding MPLADS, the BDO, Rangia informed that 6 no of schemes yet to be started. BDO was directed to communicate with the Construction Committee for starting the works early.</li> </ul>	BDO, Rangia Dev Block.

PWD (Building)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The representative of EE, NKT Building Divn. informed the House that</li> <li>A) Slab casting of Academic part of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalaya, Rangia is done.</li> <li>B) Supper structure work of the construction of Setting up High Security Prisons, Hajo under Modernization of Prison Project at Assam is going on.</li> <li>C) Power Generator set yet to be installed at ITI, Rangia.</li> </ul>	AEE, NKT (Building) Division, Rangia.
Rangia Municipal Board	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Progress of Rangia Municipal Board was reviewed.</li> <li>● Progress of PMAY-U for the year 2024-25 is 93.62%</li> <li>● PMAY-U 2.0: 1<sup>st</sup> installment fund has been released and work under progress. Total target: 316 Nos.</li> <li>● The Executive Officer (E.O.) of the Rangia Municipal Board (RMB) informed the house that, despite discussions held during the last Co-District Development Committee (CDDC) meeting, the Block Development Officer (BDO) of the Rangia Development Block has not initiated any positive response regarding the mandatory awareness meeting for the FSTP project. Consequently, the house has once again directed the representative of the Executive Engineer (EE), Public Health Engineering (PHE), and the BDO of the Rangia Development Block to take immediate initiative in this matter.</li> <li>● Rangia Town Water Supply Project under AMRUT 2.0: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– 75% progress in civil works</li> <li>– 62% progress in pipe-laying</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	EO, Rangia Municipal Board BDO, Rangia EE, PHE, Rangia
PWRD (NKT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The AEE, NKT Road division, Rangia informed that out of 139 no works, 98 nos have been completed till date.</li> <li>● Regarding ROB (Railway Over Bridge) 2023-24, some issues occur in the land vacation process. Despite receiving the full land acquisition compensation, several property owners are refusing to vacate the land as per the formal estimates. This non-compliance is causing delays in the project's commencement/execution.</li> </ul>	AEE, NKTR Division, Rangia.

Public Health Engineering	<p>The department informed that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Percentage of coverage of Household with FHTC is 88.12%</li> <li>Officials from the office of the Executive Engineer (EE), PHE, informed the house that four (4) Piped Water Supply Schemes (PWSS) are currently non-functional due to the disconnection of electricity supply. Taking note of the situation, the Chairperson directed APDCL to investigate the matter and take immediate steps to restore power to ensure the resumption of water supply.</li> </ul>	PHED/ APDCL
Fisheries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The house discussed about all the ongoing schemes under Fisheries deptt.</li> <li>As directed in the last CDDC meeting, SDVO has submitted success stories of two fish farmer</li> <li>Total Registration under NFDP (National Fisheries Digital Platform) is 6384.</li> </ul>	SDFO, Rangia

Health & Family Welfare	<p>The house discussed about progress of different programmes/schemes of the deptt.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● TB Elimination Programme: On query from Chair, the SDMO&amp;HO informed that All Nikshy Mitra are being continued their support for elimination of TB.</li> <li>● Immunization programs are going smoothly.</li> <li>● The SDM&amp;HO informed the house that under the PM-ABHIM scheme, the construction of six (6) out of eight (8) Sub-Centres has been completed. It was further updated that the remaining work at Garka SC and Tarani SC is scheduled for completion by March 2026.</li> <li>● Apollo Dialysis Centre at Rangia: No of Machine: 11 2025-26 Patient Registered: 48 Session held: 4415 No waiting patients for dialysis.</li> </ul>	Sub-Divisional Medical & Health Officer, Rangia
