

MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 20th FEBRUARY 2022 IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE OFFICE
OF THE INTEGRATED DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, KAMRUP, AMINGAON.

The list of members present in the meeting is enclosed in Annexure A

The meeting was chaired by District Development Commissioner, Kamrup and at the outset of the meeting DDC showed his dissatisfaction regarding the absence of many of the key officials like PHE, Excise Fishery etc. as a result of which many topics involving the concerned departments could not be taken up and DDC instructed to bring their absence into the notice of Deputy Commissioner.

At the outset of the meeting DDC discussed regarding the actionable points highlighted in the DC- SP conference wherein most of target has been fixed on March 2022. DDC, Kamrup informed the house that Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup is trying to keep a close monitor on the achievement of the targets fixed for different departments and co-operation from the district heads is highly solicited for achievement of the targets within the stipulated time frame.

After a threadbare discussion the following points were recorded as the key point of discussion of the meeting as follows :

1	Transport	District Transport Officer, Kamrup informed the house that against the target of Rs 42 Crores fixed for revenue collection already Rs 30 crores has already been collected and the remaining 12 Crores Rupees will be achieved within the target date. He further informed that in 2018 around 40bighas of land was allotted for construction of District Transport Office but later on they were allotted only 8 bighas of land. Though Rs 10 Crores has been sanctioned by the Transport Department as per the estimate given by PWD(B) deptt. Non allotment of appropriate land for construction of District Transport Office along with a driving track and and place to keep the seized vehicles is causing delay for construction of the Transport Office. DDC Kamrup informed the house that very recently another project for construction of another integrated Deputy Commissioner's Office to accommodate the left out office is under consideration and then necessary accommodation for the District Transport Office will be taken care of. 		<p>The Executive Engineer, PWD (B) Division II let the house know that all necessary works relating to MsDP is ongoing and will be completed within a short time.</p> <p>Further, he also let the house know that another 6 bighas of land in addition to already allotted 19 bighas of land is required for the signature project for Construction Of Mini Stadium and Football ground near Dol Gobindo Temple in North Guwahati.</p> <p>He also informed that though land/ site has been identified for Deputy Commissioner's official residence , land for the Magistrate's colony is yet to be identified for taking futher necessary action regarding sanctioning of the same.</p>	Executive Engineer, PWD (B) Div II.
3	Food & Civil Supply	The Deputy Director Food & Civil Supply, Kamrup informed the house that necessary correction for deletion of the duplicate beneficiaries entries have been made and the modified list has been uploaded.	DDS, F & CS Kamrup

Irrigation	<p>The Executive Engineer from the Irrigation department of all the subdivision let the house know that though concept of multiple cropping is already under practice still there needs to be proper awareness amongst the farmers.</p> <p>The Officials let the house know that .Low voltage in most of the areas is a matter of concern since the projects undertaken are not able to work properly due to low voltage.</p> <p>They informed regarding upgradation of the transformers for which separate budget needs to be submitted as transformer upgradation is not included in the budget . Proposals for the same has already been sent to the irrigation Department and approval for the same is awaited.</p>	Irrigation (all Divisions)
5	APDCL	<p>DDC, Kamrup informed the house that as per the circular received from the Govt. LED bulbs should be used in Offices and also in the PMAY houses. Certificates should be provided regarding the use of LED bulbs in Govt. 6	Health and Family Welfare	<p>Joint Director, Health Services, Kamrup let the house know, that institutional deliveries in most of the remote areas is a big concern since the remote areas are still not accessible for medical health . People from those areas are to be made aware about institutional deliveries and reduce mortality rates.</p> <p>Joint Director, Kamrup also informed that with the outbreak of the pandemic though attention has been diverted from Tuberculosis(TB) it is indeed a matter of concern since the mortality rate is very high due to lack of proper awareness and timely treatment.</p>	<p>Joint Director, Health Services, Kamrup.</p>
7	Sports	<p>District Sports officer informed the house that since no specific budget have been allocated for conduct of different sports in the district as such the same could not be organised in the district.</p>	
8	Water Resource(West) Division	<p>The Executive Engineer , Water Resource (West) Division let the house know due to the erection of the electrical poles, raising of embankments become a problem since its life threatening for the natives of the area due to shortening of the length/ height of the electrical poles erected.</p> <p>The Executive Engineer requested the APDCL officials to take NOC before the fixing of the electric poles to avoid such inconvenience .</p> <p>Executive Engineer also let the house know that The person concerned while making the DPR should make provision for shifting of electric poles as per circumstances.</p> <p>Executive Engineer,Water Resource(West) Division informed that in projects where silt is used Forest officials are creating issues regarding payment of Royalty . Since necessary royalties Re deducted during payment of bills as such forest officials should be informed regarding the same.</p>	<p>Water Resource(West) Division.</p>

		DDC, Kamrup informed that ADC(Admin) and the concerned departments to discuss and resolve the matter of collection of Royalty	
9	PWD(Roads)	<p>The Executive Engineer PWD (Hajo Jalukbari) Territorial Road division let the house know that Land Acquisition needs to be done in connection with the Hajo- Bongshor road as a result of which the expansion is not completed.</p> <p>The same land acquisition issue is with Chandubi Road . DDC , Kamrup ensured the house that since the land acquisition is already being monitored by Deputy Commissioner himself , the matter would be resolved at the earliest.</p> <p>Further DDC, Kamrup also informed the Executive Engineer about the dilapidated road condition of the Hajo Kalitakuchi road. The EE informed that proposal is under consideration for approval of the Hajo Kalitakuchi road.</p>	ADC(Land Acquisition)


