Subject	Minutes of the Meeting of District Development Committee of Kamrup District
Date & Time	16 th of July, 2026 at 11:00 AM
Venue	Conference Hall, O/o District Commissioner, Kamrup

The meeting was chaired by Sri Susanta Kumar Dutta, ACS, DDC, Kamrup. The meeting started with a brief presentation by the State Head of the SELCO Foundation followed by a presentation on CMO, Assam's direction for submission of unique and commendable success stories from district by i/c DIPRO, Kamrup, presented CMO, Assam's direction for submission of unique and commendable success stories from district who are working in silent for the betterment of the society. She also presented HCM's social media handle where such talent and personalities recognizing their art.

The State Head of SELCO Foundation informed that SELCO Foundation is aiming for implementation of Sustainable Livelihood projects for which cooperation and coordination from the Heads of Departments (HODs) of Agriculture, ASWCF/Agri-Horti, ASRLM, and concerned BDOs is requested.

They apprised regarding various core sectors summed up under the rules and regulation and presented an overview of the various works undertaken by the SELCO Foundation.

The following Inter-departmental issues from previous DDC Meeting and fresh issue were raised by the departments, as follows:

- Regarding the video about a wooden bridge in dilapidated condition near Shakhati High School, Boko as shared in DDC Whatsapp group, **EE, South Kamrup TRD** regarding proposal for construction of that Bridge under RIDF was submitted to Higher Authority. However, since the concerned Bridge is within the school premise and not part of public road network, the proposal was rejected earlier. DDC, Kamrup instructed Inspector of Schools, Kamrup for deputing technical persons from Education to the area and submit a status report at the earliest.
- **EE, Hajo-Sualkuchi TRD** informed regarding road issues in **Mariyapatty Road where** water pipeline of railways runs underneath the road structure, causing leakages and damage to the road. DDC, Kamrup suggested that joint visit to the location with railway authorities may be carried out for finding a solution to the issue.
- **CDC Boko-Chaygaon** informed regarding the urgent need for a **RCC bridge in Uttar Sekhadari Village where** team of officers visited the site but no progress regarding any construction activity is being done. DDC, Kamrup directed CDC, Boko-Chaygaon to submit the representation of the local inhabitants of the area and formal communication to the **EE South Kamrup TRD** to be made in this regard.

- EE, Hajo-Sualkuchi TRD has informed that since FCI has not received any formal communication regarding 6-lane road work project of the approach road in front of Integrated District Office they have refused to cooperate in the construction of drain works. He further requested District Administration to issue a notice for demolition of walls in the area for smooth implementation of the project.
- EE, PHE apprised regarding electricity discontinuation in some JJM Schemes was noted despite payments being made from the Zila Parishad (ZP) end.
AGM, APDCL informed that for smart prepaid meters, a threshold limit of up to ₹30,000/- was set. Since disconnection is handled centrally, so there is electrical discontinuation, but power gets re-connected once informed officially regarding the discontinuation till the threshold limit is not exhausted.
- JDHS reported that APDCL has installed smart prepaid meters in Primary Health Centres (PHCs) as a result of which there has been an interruption of power supply creating hindrance in operational procedures of the PHCs viz. operation theatre, laboratory etc.
- **DPM, ASRLM** informed that out of 46 CLF sent to Cooperation department for registration, only 12CLFs were registered and 34 remains pending. DDC directed ARCS to Share the official contact number to DPM ASRLM to facilitate smooth cooperation and resolution
- **EE, PWD, South Kamrup TRD and CEO, Kamrup ZP** has pointed out that a court instruction regarding suo moto case on stray animals has been received by the Departments and Action Taken Report is sought from the authority. A request has been made to AH & Vety Department to act as Nodal agency for communication and implementation of court's instructions regarding the matter.

After threadbare discussion the following discussion were taken.
